Crown Reserves have been established for a broad range of purposes. The spectrum of visitors to the grounds might include:

- Clubs (Dog, Pony, Equestrian, Rugby League, Women's Rugby, Men's Shed, Landcare Groups and more) -plus their members and supporters
- Shows –Agricultural, Equestrian, Art/Cultural, Exhibitions, Expos, Markets and their Marshals, Competitors and Visitors
- Travellers and Campers – and their Visitors, Companion Animals/Livestock
- Showground Pavilion Users– Function Organisers, Attendees, Members
- Recreational Facilities – general users of Sport Fields, Arenas, Stables, Yards, Wash Bays, Event Sites, Amenities and other similar Facilities
- Conservation Areas – Walkers, Riders, Runners, Flora and Fauna Carers.

Terms & Conditions for Staying at Morisset Showground

Morisset Showground is a Crown Reserve of the NSW Department of Primary Industry and is managed by the Morisset Showground Trust. All members of the Trust and other workers at the showground are volunteers. All users of the showground are bound by the Crown Lands Act 2016 and by-laws associated with the act. Reserve trusts have the authority to manage behaviour and access in order to protect the reserve. This includes enforcing the laws and by-laws which apply to the reserve.

Fees Per Site: (2 people)

- **Powered Site \$25.00**
- **Non-Powered \$20.00**
- Extra person using the same site \$5.00 per person
- Only accommodation and one car is allowed per site.
- All additional trailers / cars will be charged \$25 per week as storage.
- Fees are subject to change without notice.
- All Fees must be paid in advance to the Caretaker (located in the bus next to the breezeway).
- **All Fees Payable by EFTPOS– electronic receipts can be issued.**

All visitors must be aware of the following:

- The availability of sites is at the Discretion of the Trust
- The Trust reserves the right to refuse or terminate visitation at any time to any person/s without any redress or reason to evict any person/s and remove their property from the showground
- The maximum stay for visitors with vehicles is 4 weeks
- The maximum stay for visitors staying in tents is 2 weeks

All Children (under 12yrs) must be accompanied / supervised by an adult AT ALL TIMES whilst at the grounds / using any amenities.

- Pets / Livestock are generally accepted. They are only accepted providing all faeces are cleaned up, are kept safely contained/ walked on a lead and do not make undue noise or disturb other campers

- Environment: No damaging or interfering with turfed areas, trees, shrubs, fauna, plants or plant material, soils, sand or rocks
- Behaviour should not be riotous, disorderly, indecent, offensive, threat-ening or insulting that may cause disturbance or be a nuisance or annoy-ance to other visitors at the grounds or to neighbouring property's
- No damaging or disturbing the ground surface, no digging trenches around tents, across roads, extending leads/ hoses across access ways
- No burying rubbish or litter. All food scraps should be well wrapped before it is disposed of in refuse containers provided
- Use of Generators: Using or running a generator between the hours of 9:30pm and 7:00am is prohibited
- All sites must be left clean, undamaged, with all rubbish removed
- No washing of Cars or any Trailers as ALL water is precious. Please be water wise when showering and limit showers to 4 minutes
- No swearing. Any activities should be safe and socially acceptable and be conducted in a way that does not affect other users of the reserve
- Noise be kept to a minimum after 10pm. Disturbance to others including excessive noise or inappropriate behaviour at any time is prohibited and will result in ejection from the property without refund
- Helmets must be worn when riding bikes / horses on the showground
- No maintenance or repairs to any part of or facilities on the grounds. Any improvements /alterations must have prior approval from the Trust
- ALL vehicles must be registered– Cars, Trailers, Floats, Trucks
- Shower Entry Pin Number will be provided by the caretaker. Please do not use TALCUM powder within showers / amenity buildings
- The hirer indemnifies and holds harmless the Showground Trust in respect of all actions, suits, proceedings, claims, demands, losses, costs, charges, any loss of revenue, loss of profits, loss of business opportunities, loss of anticipated savings, damage to goodwill and damage to reputation and also including the cost of any settling any pending or threatened proceedings, including legal expenses on a solicitor arising from or incurred for any reason
- Sewerage – a dump point is available, please see the caretaker
- Please Drive Slowly – the speed limit on the grounds is 15km per hour
- Fire Safety - all vans, motor homes or any kind of mobile accommodation must be equipped with smoke detector alarm, fire blanket and fire extinguisher.
